Attendance/ Welcome, Opening Prayer – Msgr. Funk opened in prayer

Prayer intentions: Book passed

Approve April Minutes: Bill motioned to approve April minutes, Gervase second, motion carried

Pastor Report: 2 servers will be receiving the Sierra (spelling?) Server award on Mother’s Day, Caroline Berger and Piper Ogden. SPX will be hosting seminarian Cassin Harmon, starting mid-May for about 10 weeks. SPX will be hosting a reception for Fr. Metzger’s 50th Anniversary on 5/28 after the 10:15 Mass. Cyndi will check with Leah to see if the Women’s Group can assist with hosting the reception. Bishop’s Annual Appeal begins this Sunday, goal has been upped to \$144,000 and change. SPX received \$21,000 back and this will be used for an electronic marquis to replace the current sign out front.

Goal 1 – Capital Campaign: We are close to reaching the 3 million goal and pledges continue to come in. SPX has received approval from the Bishop to have Hohman Hall completely built.

Goal 2 – Prayerfulness: Scheduled hours for Adoration will remain the same. Msgr. Will arrange for the church to be locked, he can have the Seminarian lock the church when done. During the summer choir is off and Katie has summer hours. Msgr. Suggested we have a sign in book for Adoration so we know what times are being covered. Jeanne will get a book and Msgr. Will check and see if we can use the podium that is in the rectory basement. We will ask parishioners to confirm the times they are coming, some need to change their times or not come during the summer. Cyndi will check with Denise for the book of sign ups and the poster. We will need to have a time for sign-ups again and display the poster, perhaps something in the bulletin and pulpit announcement.

Goal 3 – Social – Brian provide update on licensing issue: Brian not in attendance.

New PAC members – 2 slots have been filled, we could add 2 more, we should have at least 13 and no more than 20 including Msgr. Sr. Rep and Youth rep aren’t included in the total 13. We have 9 returning members.
